Science & Arts Financial Aid Office's *Statement of Ethical Principles* provides that the primary goal of the institutional financial aid professional is to help students achieve their educational potential by providing appropriate financial resources. To ensure a high standard of ethical conduct the Science & Arts Financial Aid Office has adopted the following Code of Ethics.

The financial aid professional shall:

- 1. Be committed to removing financial barriers for those who wish to pursue postsecondary learning.
- 2. Make every effort to assist students with financial aid. Be aware of the issues affecting students and advocate their interests at the institutional, state and federal levels.
- 3. Educate students and families through quality consumer information.
- 4. Respect the dignity and protect the privacy of students and ensure the confidentiality of student records and personal circumstances.
- 5. Ensure equity by applying all need analysis formulas consistently across the institution's full population of student financial aid applicants.
- 6. Provide services that do not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, ethnicity, sexual orientation, religion, disability, age, or economic status.
- 7. Recognize the need for professional development and continuing education opportunities.
- 8. Promote the free expression of ideas and opinions, and foster respect for diverse viewpoints within the profession.
- 9. Commit to the highest level of ethical behavior and refrain from conflict of interest or the perception thereof.
- 10. Maintain the highest level of professionalism, reflecting a commitment to the goals of the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma.
