## BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA:

HR will hold an info session that will give students an in-depth tutorial on how to use All Voices. There will also be a movie a movie night that will have the theme of consent. Also, a booth outside the Café will have pamphlets about consent to go along with the "Consent Cookies."
- SECTION 5: \$250 will be allocated from the SGA General Funds for all activities and events. All unused funds will go back to the SGA General Funds.
- SECTION 6: Copies of this act shall be distributed to the following: All Current members of the USAO Government Association (SGA) Senate, all current members of the SGA Executive Council, all current members of the SGA Supreme Court, and all current advisors of the SGA.
