Drover Den Renovations

A bill relating to allocating \$1,000 of the General Funds to be reserved for any expenses accrued for the Drover Den Renovations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: This bill shall be known and cited as the Drover Den Renovation Bill.

SECTION 2: This funding is needed to help in the renovation of the Drover Den. To aid in the committee's quest of providing a space where students can connect, seek comfort, study, and provide more entrainmanet options here on campus.

SECTION 3: The Student Government Association would aid in renovating the Drovers Den to be a spot that brings the campus together. This would go into effect immediately and our hopes are to be done by the end of this semester. The Drover Den Renovation committee members along with Annie Roberts have been working hard to think of ways to make the space more inclusive, aiming for an environment that allows students to interact and resonate more with the campus.

SECTION 4: The first step in renovating is painting the walls of the drovers den which will make the space look newer. Then, new furniture will be bought and placed (ie. :couches tables, study pockets, etc). This will start the dividing of the drovers den into spaces designed for specific activities (ie. studying, relaxing, playing). Then, decor and art will be added. We hope to include the student body in the decor process by holding an event in which students can paint ceiling tiles (rules will be in place and upheld). This allows for art students to get their art and name out there.
