11 12 13	WHEREAS: The Student Association Senate is the representative body for the students of the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma and the unified voice that affirms students' concerns; and,
14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS: College students as a whole frequently struggle with depression, anxiety, and other mental health disorders that can be as debilitating as physical health disorders; and,
19 20 21	WHEREAS: The University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma has around 1000 students on campus but few mental health counselors to accommodate for them; and,
22 23 24	WHEREAS: Having limited availability for counseling sessions can disincentivize students to schedule regular sessions with the counseling faculty; and,
25 26 27	WHEREAS: The precedent that one counseling session can heal mental health disorders and students' problems is false; and,
28 29 30	WHEREAS: Having healthy mental health is the cornerstone for student success and counseling services directly impact this; and,
31 32 33	WHEREAS: The appointment load on the current counselors on campus is far too large to handle.
34 35 36	NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA THAT:
37 38 39 40 41 42 43	SECTION 1: The Student Government Association shall immediately and strongly urge the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma to hire additional mental health counselors, implement a system where setting up for regularly scheduled therapy sessions is possible and encouraged, make mental health services more accessible to students overall, and increase advertisement of mental health services on campus so students are aware of them.
