#### New Business

A. Senate Resolution #12042022-01: Resolution to Condemn Anti-Semitism

- Asking the body and USAO to reaffirm and condemn antisemitism. Due to recent remarks by celebrities, it makes sense for usao to stand in solidarity with the Jewish population. The outcome would potentially welcome more Jewish students at USAO
- a. Fryhover How will we get out to student body that we condemn this?
- b. Author Moses SGA send out campus wide email
- c. Leamon-Webb POI: Typically, we send out emails but all SGA can do is show this is our representation. We will do everything we can to do this.
- d. Moses SGA can't do a lot other than raise awareness
- e. Humphrey POI: We have the ability to send out messages through canvas. Nothing in our constitution allows emails to everyone.
- f. Alldredge motions to move on to section B
- B. Senate Bill #12042022-02: Warm for the Weather Act
- To act in Fall '23. Bill states that SGA funds \$165 for new winter clothes for the pantry. College kids are money tight and need winter clothes. Not enough donations so we need donations from SGA.
  - a. Willoughby Would we want to take money from SGA this year rather than next year
  - b. Fryhover Good point: No real time limit but figured it would make sense to do it before next year
- c. Willoughby Can we make an amendment to put this into place for Spring '23 instead of Spring '24?
- d. Humphrey No need for amendment
- e. Bagy motions to vote for bill on a block by roll call
- i. Both bills pass unanimously.
