12 13	University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma and the unified voice that affirms students' concerns; and,

16	concern on campus; and,

18	WHEREAS: Many places on campus, including classrooms like the Davis Hall Amphitheater,
19	have steps with no visibility strips; and,
20	
21	WHEREAS: Because visibility strips greatly benefit visually impaired individuals, the lack of
22	them creates a potentially dangerous environment on campus; and,
23	
24	WHEREAS: As the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma grows and becomes more
25 26	diverse, our visually impaired student population will also continue to grow; and,
26 27	WHEREAS: Classrooms like the Davis Hall Amphitheater hold most Interdisciplinary Studies
28	courses, which all USAO students are required to take, and therefore makes
20 29	accessibility even more crucial.

31	NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION
32	SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND ARTS OF OKLAHOMA THAT:

34	SECTION 1: The Student Government Association shall urge the University of Science and Arts
35	of Oklahoma to place visibility strips on the steps of the Davis Hall Amphitheatre
36	and any other place on campus with steps to create a safer environment for
37	students who are visually impaired.
